PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Patient Care Ombudsman ("PCO") hereby files his Response to the NOTICE OF ADJOURNED AUCTION RE DEBTOR'S NOTICE OF MOTION AND MOTION FOR THE ENTRY OF (I) AN ORDER (I) APPROVING FORM OF ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT; (2) APPROVING AUCTION SALE FORMAT AND BIDDING PROCEDURES, (3) APPROVING PROCESS FOR DISCRETIONARY SELECTION OF STALKING HORSE BIDDER AND BID PROTECTIONS; (4) APPROVING FORM OF NOTICE TO BE PROVIDED TO INTERESTED PARTIES; (5) SCHEDULING A COURT HEARING TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE SALE TO THE HIGHEST AND BEST BIDDER; AND (6) APPROVING PROCEDURES RELATED TO THE ASSUMPTION OF CERTAIN EXECUTORY CONTRACTS AND UNEXPIRED LEASES; AND (II) AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PROPERTY FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL CLAIMS, LIENS AND ENCUMBRANCES (the "Notice") filed by Borrego Community Health Foundation, debtor and debtor in possession herein ("Debtor").

As the Court is aware, the PCO is charged with the duty to ensure proper patient care. This is even more critical when facilities are being sold or transferred to third parties and the PCO must be involved to ensure proper transition and avoidance of disruption or harm to patient care. Prior to the scheduled auction, the PCO was provided, and reviewed, prospective bidder information and discussed his concerns and issues with representatives of the Debtor. However, until a prospective purchaser is determined, it would be economically impractical for the PCO to interview all bidders and analyze their business operations and strategy with respect to the Debtor and its patients. The PCO, therefore, determined that he will monitor the auction with any questions he may have and then interview the winning bidder and the backup bidder for additional information. In the interest of saving costs, the PCO was provided with a Zoom link to monitor the auction, but the auction did not go live and the PCO was not aware of the developments behind the scenes.

According to the Notice, there will no longer be an auction, but, rather, the Debtor will select a winning and backup bidder. Response deadlines have not been extended in connection with this new process. Pursuant

to this Response, the PCO seeks to put the Court and all parties on notice that, upon determination of prospective purchaser(s), the PCO intends to conduct investigation and interviews to ensure that patient care is preserved in connection with the contemplated transitions. The PCO does not anticipate that such efforts will impair or delay the sale process. However, such a process is necessary to carry out the duties and obligations of the PCO and, if necessary, the PCO will file appropriate position paper with the Court.
