

1 The Court has considered the *Liquidating Trusts' Ninth Omnibus Motion for Order*
2 *(1) Disallowing Claims (Duplicate Claims); (2) Disallowing Claims (Wrong Debtor); and (3)*
3 *Disallowing Claims (Amended and Superseded Claims)* (Docket No. 2841) (the "Objection"), filed
4 on March 3, 2014 by the PC Trusts, by and through the Liquidating Trustee, seeking entry of an
5 order disallowing and expunging certain claims.²

6 The Court considered the Objection and all related papers and documents. No
7 timely written opposition was filed in response to the Objection.

8 The Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to sections 157 and 1334 of
9 Title 28 of the United States Code, and the Court finds the form, scope and timing of notice of the
10 Motion was adequate under the circumstances of these cases.³

11 Based upon the foregoing and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is
12 hereby:

13 **ORDERED THAT:**

14 1. The Objection is sustained with respect to the following claims (the
15 "Claims") listed on Exhibits A, B, and C of the Objection and identified on the Debtors' Claims
16 Dockets with the associated numbers:
