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This Court has considered the *Debtor's Motion for a Supplemental Order Increasing the Monthly Caps Authorized Under the Court's Previous Order (I) Authorizing the Retention and Payment, Effective as of the Petition Date, of Professionals Utilized by the Debtor in the Ordinary Course of Business and (II) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 1031] (the "Motion"), the Bongiovanni Declaration in support thereof, all other filings in support of the Motion, and the statements of counsel at the hearing on the Motion. This Court has found (i) this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (ii) venue is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409 and (iii) notice of the Motion and the hearing was sufficient under the circumstances. After due deliberation, the Court having determined that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate and its creditors, and good and sufficient cause having been shown;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Motion is GRANTED as set forth herein.
- 2. The limit on monthly compensation permitted to be paid to each individual Ordinary Course Professional is increased to \$75,000 per month (calculated on a three-month rolling average).
- 3. The limit on total monthly compensation permitted to be paid across all Ordinary Course Professionals is increased to \$200,000 per month (calculated on a three-month rolling average).
- 4. The Debtor is permitted to seek further authorization from this Court to increase the monthly caps in the future if warranted.
- 5. Neither Entry of this Order nor entry of the OCP Order affects the Debtor's right to dispute any invoice submitted by an Ordinary Course Professional.
- 6. Other than the changes in monthly compensation limits approved herein, the OCP Order [Docket No. 263] otherwise remains in full force and effect.
- 7. The Debtor is hereby authorized to take such actions and to execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the relief granted by this Order.
