The Debtors have notified the Court that they wish to continue the hearing on certain Cure Objections based solely on 11 U.S.C. § 365 to allow the parties further time to resolve such objections. The Debtors do not propose to continue any objections to the Sale(s) arising under 11 U.S.C. § 363 or other applicable law.
